



Face Covering Policy

Whereas Freedom Preparatory Academy is an AOI only school and does not operate a physical campus, it does not require face coverings for distance learners. If and when FPA opts to open a physical campus or provide in-person instruction in excess of 20 students, it will follow state mandates and school-related requirements for face coverings. The following points outline expectations for campus-based in-person instruction.

- As required by state/local authorities, students and staff will be expected to wear face coverings while on campus. If authorities lift this requirement, face coverings will become optional but recommended.
- Students are expected to conduct a self-screening of body temperature and other COVID-19-related symptoms prior to arriving on campus.
- Students shall wash their hands before and after lunch and before and after leaving the campus.
- Additional cleaning measures will be in place to sanitize high touch surfaces daily. Evening custodians will sanitize the entire building each evening.
- Parents and visitors will not be permitted on campus, with the exception of late drop-offs and early pick-ups.
