Measures for Reopening for In-Person Instruction

Whereas Freedom Preparatory Academy is an AOI only school and does not operate a physical campus, it does not intend to reopen any schools for in-person instruction. If and when FPA opts to open a physical campus or provide in-person instruction in excess of 20 students, it will follow the benchmarks and measures outlined below to ensure safe and responsible in-person instruction.

Benchmark 1 – Cases

2 consecutive weeks where Arizona falls within or below the ADHS moderate range of fewer than 100 new cases per 100,000.

Note: For [Maricopa County](#), this benchmark was met after the week of July 19, which was the second consecutive week of decreased case rates. Since then the number of cases in the county has continued to decline.

Note: For [Pinal County](#), (on map, click Pinal County) this benchmark was met July 19, when cases dipped below 100 per 100,000 and has stayed below 100. In addition, the number of cases has been trending downward.

Benchmark 2 – Percent Positivity

2 consecutive weeks where percent positivity rates fall within or below the ADHS moderate range of 5% to 10%.

The [ADHS Data Dashboard](#) provides up-to-date data of percent positivity. Users can click on the “Laboratory Testing” icon, then on any county in the map, and scroll to the table where to hover over a specific date on the PCR graph.

Benchmark 3 – COVID-like Illness

2 consecutive weeks where hospital visits exhibiting COVID-like illnesses fall within or below the ADHS moderate range of 5% to 10%.

In addition to these data points, FPA administration and staff will consider guidance from county health officials, community needs, and available resources to determine if and when in-person instruction may be offered.
